The Net Party (Partido de la Red)

The Net Party is a political party that aims to improve democracy by taking advantage of modern digital technology. Specifically, it proposes a model of citizen participation that is a hybrid of direct democracy and representative democracy.

The party was founded by Santiago Siri and Estaban Brenman in April 2012. It received the required support of 4000 citizens (to officially exist as a party) in August 2013, and ran for a seat in the local parliament of Buenos Aires during the October 2013 elections achieving 21,000 votes (1% of the votes). It is currently working to improve DemocracyOS and to get its first congressman elected in the 2017 elections.

The hallmark of a representative from the Net Party is that their vote will always be bound to the vote of their constituents on every bill in the Democracy OS platform. The innovation of the Net Party is its linkage to the formal political system through a "Trojan legislator".

DemocracyOS

The DemocracyOS (DOS) software is an online space for deliberation and voting on policy proposals. The software aims to stimulate better arguments and reach better decisions collectively. This is a platform where 100% of the citizens can vote on each bill.

It has two main mechanisms: the validation of identity and how to vote.

The identity validation is a crucial component and is achieved through an account with a valid e-mail address. Identity validation ensures that all expression is 100% legitimate. Later, a separate app called NetIdentity will allow use of any of the online credentials (email, Facebook, Twitter) to validate the identity.

Regarding how to vote, every citizen can vote directly on the proposals made on each specific topic, or may choose to delegate a vote to another citizen that he/she considers is more expert in the subject. (It

will not be an automatic delegation, but must be validated at each ballot).
